## Backpack Program Shopping List

Please consider donating to the Backpack Program by picking up one of the inexpensive items listed below on your next shopping trip. Then drop off your food donations at the Hickory Elks Lodge all during the months of October and November. Ring the bell on the side entrance. We are located at 356 Main Avenue NW on the corner of 4th Street and Main Avenue. The donation box is located just inside door.

**Food items that are GREAT for the Backpack Program:**

- Macaroni and Cheese or Easy Mac
- Pudding Cups (unrefrigerated)
- Microwave Meals (unrefrigerated)
- Pop top can meals (Chef Boyardee)
- Fruit Cups (unrefrigerated)
- Peanut Butter (plastic container)
- Small cereal boxes (single serve, not regular sizes)
- Oatmeal or Grits (in packets)
- Apple Sauce (plastic container)
- Granola/Fruit Bars
- Easy to open cans of soup or fruit
- Tuna or canned chicken
- Gummy Snacks (individually wrapped)
- Jelly (plastic container)

**Food items that a NOT great for the Backpacks:**

- Candy
- Cookies
- Soda
- Food items in glass containers

The goal of the program is to provide children who are hungry with nutritional meals over the weekend. The food you donate will be packed into a backpack and given to children at school each Friday during the 2015-2016 school year.

Also consider donating \$100 to sponsor one child who will benefit from the Backpack Program for a year. These funds will be used to purchase food for those students in need.
